

HTI-1 Rule Compliance: December 31, 2025

Throttle up by improving transparency and interoperability using APIs based on the Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources (FHIR®) standard.

Next Steps for Compliance:

- Install FHIR-based APIs to keep secure, real-time data transmission running smoothly
- Avoid information blocking slow-downs with clear data-sharing policies
- Get your pit crew prepped for enhanced workflows and reduce data silos



CMS-0057-F Rule Compliance: January 1, 2027

Coming into the turn, the Interoperability and ePA Final Rule milestone requires real-time electronic prior authorization (ePA) using FHIR standards.



- Shift data exchange into high gear with fully implemented FHIR APIs
- Standardize ePA processes to simplify workflows
- Boost transparency with real-time status updates on PA requests and documented decision timelines



HTI-2 Rule Compliance: January 1, 2028

HTI-2 turbocharges HTI-1 by requiring detailed, real-time data sharing to support patient data access, interoperability, and the use of health IT to improve outcomes.

Next Steps for Compliance:

- Upgrade your EHR to allow for more granular data exchange, ensuring smooth transitions
- Bolster data privacy to handle increased patient control over their data
- Team up with FHIR API experts to strengthen data sharing with external systems
